Course Description:

This course prepares participants to deliver Federal Emergency Management Agency's CERT Basic Training course.

Course Goal:

This train-the-trainer course focuses on preparing instructors to:

- Deliver the CERT Basic Training
- Convey the messages and intent of the CERT Program (e.g., safety, teamwork, place in overall community emergency operations plan)
- Assure that students achieve the objectives of the CERT Basic Training
- Create a comfortable, yet managed learning environment.

Prerequisite:

Participants in this course must have:

- A referral from a CERT-sponsoring agency, typically a Local, Regional, or State government agency
- Completed the CERT Basic Training course or IS317: Introduction to CERT (<http://www.citizencorps.gov/cert/IS317/>)

Course Length:

3 days

Target Audience:

The audience for this course includes professionals and volunteers who are designated to be or are CERT Program Trainers.
