Change in Prerequisites

The Emergency Management Institute (EMI) has slightly adjusted the MEPP prerequisites to include selected resident and non-resident (E/B/L) coded and G-coded courses (administered by States and other training providers).

The following Independent Study (IS) requirements can be met with completion of specific courses for the following:

IS-130 Exercise Evaluation and Improvement Planning

*Individuals who have completed the E/B/L 131 Exercise Evaluation and Improvement Planning course may choose to submit a course certificate in lieu of completing the IS-130 requirement. EMI has conducted this course both in residence and offsite.

*Individuals who have completed the G-235 Emergency Planning course may choose to submit a course certificate in lieu of completing the IS-235.a requirement.

*Individuals who have completed the G-775 Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Management and Operations course may choose to submit a course certificate in lieu of completing the IS-775 requirement.
