## **Course:** *E915 - Integrated Emergency Management Course (IEMC): Homeland Security - Openings Available*

This IEMC focuses on preparing for and responding to terrorist events. The exercise components place public officials and other key community leaders in a disaster simulation. The preparation for, response to, and recovery from a terrorist event are identified and discussed through classroom didactics and exercise components of this 4-day course. Course methodologies of classroom sessions and exercises allow for structured decision-making in a learning, yet realistic environment.
