Course: E920 - Integrated Emergency Management Course (IEMC): Hazardous Materials - Openings Available

This IEMC focuses on preparing for and responding to a hazardous materials event. The exercise components place public officials and other key community leaders in a disaster simulation. Identification and discussions of hazardous materials planning, policies and procedures are also included in the 4-day course. Course methodologies of classroom sessions and exercises allow for structured decision-making in a learning, yet realistic environment.
