Course: *E0179 Hazards United States-Multi-Hazards (HAZUS-MH) for Disaster Operations*

Date: January 28-31, 2013

Course Description:

This course is designed to increase the level of awareness and knowledge of Federal and State emergency management officials of the capabilities of HAZUS-MH, the information and analyses requirements of key sections at the Regional Response Coordination Center (RRCC) and the Joint Field Office (JFO), and the potential applications of HAZUS-MH to support decisions at the RRCC, Emergency Support Team (EST), and the JFO. Areas of focus include hurricane disaster operations, mitigation, Individual Assistance (IA), and Public Assistance (PA). This course also provides a description of the full range of potential uses of HAZUS-MH analyses into strategies for mitigation, IA, and PA.

Course Goal:

This course provides the necessary skills for local, State, and Federal Emergency Managers and GIS personnel to assist decision-makers at the RRCC, EST, and JFO to prepare, mitigate, respond, and recover from Hurricane, flood, and earthquake events.

Course Length:

This course is 4 days in length. Travel days are Sunday and Friday.

Continuing Education Units:

The Emergency Management Institute (EMI) awards 2.8 CEUs for completion of this course.

Pre-Requisites:

Strong Geographic Information System (GIS) experience and completion of the E/L313 Basic HAZUS-MH course are required. Recommend completion of the E/L317 Comprehensive Data Management for HAZUS-MH course. Participants must currently use or be planning to use GIS and HAZUS.

Target Audience:

This course is intended for the following: State and local emergency planners and GIS specialists, State and local planners, regional personnel with responsibility for mitigation and response activities, and other Federal agencies with risk assessment responsibilities.

How do I obtain my FEMA SID number?


- Step 1: To register, go to <https://cdp.dhs.gov/elms>
- Step 2: Click on the “Create Account” button on the left side of the screen.
- Step 3: Follow the instructions and provide the necessary information to create your account.

What do I do with this new SID number I have been assigned?

The SID number should be used in place of the SSN on your General Admissions Application (FEMA Form 119-25-1). When you enter and use the system you will be able to print off and retain a student identification card.
