Participants in this course must have:

1. A referral from a CERT-sponsoring agency, typically a local, regional, or state government agency.
2. If you are not a first responder, the CERT Basic Training is required.
3. For current first responders, [IS-317: Introduction to CERT](https://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-317.a), will familiarize you with the CERT Program (https://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-317.a).

Class size limited to 20 students (for the pilot only).

This course prepares participants to deliver the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) CERT Basic Training course.
