### **General Information**

The National Disaster & Emergency Management University (NDEMU) Curriculum Standards and Instructional Technology Branch provides the Independent Study Program (ISP).

This is a distance learning program which offers training, online and free of charge, to the nation's emergency management network and the general public.

It serves as both an alternative means to deliver valuable training to the professional and volunteer emergency management community as well as an opportunity to improve public awareness and promote disaster preparedness nationally.


The <u>Independent Study Program</u> currently offers nearly 200 online courses via our training website.

#### In addition...

The <u>NEDMU Student Portal</u> was launched in July 2022 and allows students to access their training records and completion documents online.

Students obtain continuing education units for most ISP courses. Students can also request an Official Transcript to be sent to a college or university for the purposes of accreditation.

### How to get Started

The fastest way to begin taking courses is to visit our website. You can learn about each course, download materials, and take courses interactively.

- 2. Create/review your Login.gov account
- 3. Visit the Independent Study Website
- 4. Select IS Course List
- 5. Select your course of interest

Once you have studied the training material, you can submit your final exam, all from the convenience of your home or office.
