Process: The application window is from early May to August 29, 2014, with the formal selection board in September, and announcement no later than October 10, 2014.

May 4-7, 2015 - E0452 Leadership II: Application of Personal Leadership in Emergency Management

August 17-20, 2015 - E0453 Leadership III: Leadership in the Emergency Management Organization

TBD, 2016 - E0454 Leadership IV: Emergency Management Leadership in the Community and Profession

*Note - Other class dates are available throughout the year for earlier cohorts, but those admitted in Cohort #5 must attend the courses in order (E0451, E0452, E0453 and E0454).

Four full days of class. Monday through Thursday class is from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

How to Apply: All interested personnel should first contact the Leaders Academy Program Manager, Todd Wheeler at Todd.Wheeler@fema.dhs.gov, who will provide additional instructions and all required applications documents. This will assist you in ensuring a complete application packet.

Each application must include the following:

1. A letter from the applicant requesting admission to the program and specifying the applicant's qualifications and perceived expectations of the program.
2. A General Admission Application Form or FEMA Form 119-25-1 (*obtain from the program manager*). Item 9.a. on the form should state "EMI National EM Leaders Academy".
3. The Leaders Academy questionnaire (*obtain from the program manager*).
4. A letter of recommendation from the applicant's immediate supervisor indicating the organization's commitment to allow the applicant to complete the entire program.
5. The applicant's signed commitment statement (*obtain from the program manager*) indicating their commitment to complete the entire program to include the four resident courses at EMI, the Leaders Academy Action Project, and pre-course requirements.
