



### Course: **L0363 Multi-Hazard Emergency Management for Higher Education**

This Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Emergency Management Institution (EMI) course is designed to be delivered to **teams of higher education campus personnel and their emergency partners** who are responsible for creating, reviewing, implementing and exercising emergency operations plans (EOPs).
