



K0431 – Understanding Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC) – Virtual

Course Dates:

March 6–9, 2023

Course Length:

This virtual course will be held over 4 consecutive days from 12:00 noon–4 p.m. EST.

Course Description:

This course enables emergency management, response, and recovery personnel from all political jurisdictions to understand, activate, implement, and use the EMAC system more effectively. The course will be conducted virtually via Adobe Connect.

Goal:

The goal is to introduce emergency management, response, and recovery personnel to EMAC and the EMAC process so they can knowledgeably use the nation's interstate mutual aid system.

Pre-Requisites:

None

Target Audience/Selection Criteria:

- Personnel from any jurisdiction or organization who can be legally deployed via EMAC, or
- Personnel from organizations who may request or provide assistance via EMAC, or
- Individuals desiring a more comprehensive working knowledge of EMAC
