The rise in the volume and complexity of risks facing organizations - whether from insider threats, cyber-attacks, physical attacks or reputational damage - requires a strategic approach to identifying, mitigating, transferring and avoiding risk, as well as protecting assets (human and physical). Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) is a structured, proven process for the proactive identification and evaluation of how events and forces of change impact an organization and its strategy, and for developing measures for dealing with the risks that constantly threaten the achievement of an organization's objectives. Enterprise risk managers provide the leadership, innovation, and management skills necessary to identify, evaluate, manage, and monitor an organization's portfolio of risks.

The curriculum is intended for: Enterprise Risk Managers, Strategic Advisors, Business Continuity Planners, Managers in Business Resiliency & Risk Reduction, Operational Risk Managers, Finance Executives, Human Resource Professionals and Executives serving on Non-Profit boards.
