

Clackamas Community College – Associate of Applied Science Degree in Emergency Management

Clackamas Community College is offering an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Emergency Management. It is offered through the Wilsonville Campus/Apprenticeship/Fire Science/Emergency Management Department in partnership with Oregon Emergency Management.

The degree is designed to provide both, emergency services professionals a resource for academic recognition of their training, as well as providing anyone interested in becoming an emergency services professional the educational opportunity to do so.

The degree incorporates basic emergency management training courses offered through the field delivery program of the Emergency Management Institute (EMI), EMI's Independent Study Program, State and local developed and sponsored courses, and nationally recognized Incident Command System (ICS) courses.

90 credit hours are required to complete the program.

Required Courses:

10 Credits minimum Related Instruction

20 Credits Emergency Management Supplemental Electives

14 Credits of Supplemental Emergency Management Electives (approved by CCC) or

Any electives 100 level or above, taken from a regionally accredited college.

Clackamas Community College is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities.
