

## **Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU), Daytona Beach - Minor in Terrorism Studies**

The terrorism studies minor (15 credits, 5 courses) combines several advanced topics in terrorism such as irregular warfare, concerns about transnational asymmetric insurgencies, counterterrorism strategies and policy, and counter intelligence strategies with upper level courses in international relations. Of the five total courses, students choose two international relations courses from a large list of course in order to more deeply develop an appreciation of the issues and challenges that terrorists present in various nations and cultures and how those impact the U.S.

Courses used in the International Relations or the International History Minor cannot be used in the Terrorism Studies Minor.
