Florida A&M University is offering a Bachelor of Science in Political Science with Concentration in Emergency Management. The Bachelor of Science in Political Science with Concentration in Emergency Management is designed for students planning a career in active politics, law, government including the Foreign Service, international business and industrial organizations, teaching, research, public relations and private enterprise.

All political science majors must complete a minor of eighteen hours in another academic field. A major in political science consists of thirty-three semester hours. Students wishing to minor in Emergency Management must complete eighteen semester hours. Students must complete a total of 120 semester hours to earn the Bachelor of Science in Political Science with Concentration in Emergency Management
