

## **Frederick Community College - College Credit Conversion Program**

Frederick Community College (FCC), through an exclusive contract with JACOBS supporting the FEMA-EMI Independent Study (IS) Program, allows students to convert their IS courses taken from FEMA into college credit at FCC. The student's converted credit will be available on an official FCC transcript to go towards promotion opportunities, performance appraisals; and/or career enhancement. Students may also transfer their college credits to other colleges and universities. Courses generally transfer as an open elective credit. \*The converted college credit will be awarded a grade of "Pass." If the student requires a GPA on their transcript, students can earn letter grades through FCC's distance education module participation and progress toward an Associate Degree of Applied Science in Emergency Management, Certificate, and Letter of Recognition program.
