The Master of Science in Protection Management with an Emergency Management Concentration provides advanced professional education in theory, design, management, and operation of emergency-management systems. The curriculum consists of courses in management and analysis, foundations of security, fire safety, and risk management, and an elective. The program emphasizes the development of managerial, analytic, and technical capabilities in the context of organizational and societal influences.
