

Justice Institute of British Columbia - Diploma in Emergency and Security Management

The Diploma in Emergency and Security Management is a 60-credit, multi-disciplinary program designed specifically to meet the safety, security, and emergency management challenges of today and tomorrow. It provides students with the basic conceptual approaches and methodologies of security and emergency management as they apply to business and community environments. Graduates have the theoretical, methodological, and technical competencies required for a career in security and emergency management.

Upon completion of the diploma, students have the choice of continuing in the third year of the Bachelor of Emergency and Security Management Studies program.

The Diploma in Emergency and Security Management is offered completely online. Students can choose to pursue their studies full time or part time. New students can start the program at the beginning of any semester (September, January, and May).

Required Courses:

Students complete 60 credits (20 courses):

- 33 credits (11 courses) of required emergency management and security courses; and
- 27 credits (9 courses) of required liberal studies and business courses.
