Nash Community College currently offers an Emergency Management Associate Degree program. The program curriculum will provide basic knowledge to enable the student to deal with a multitude of emergencies on the local and state level. Course work in the classroom and laboratory exercises introduces students to various aspects of emergency preparedness, protection, and enforcement. Students will learn technical and administrative skills such as investigative principles, hazardous materials, codes, standards, emergency operations, and finance.

Courses in the Emergency Management Associate Degree program are offered on a rotating schedule affording employed students an opportunity to attend class on days that do not interfere with a work schedule. Courses are also offered online.
