

Nova Southeastern University, Fort Lauderdale-Davie - Master of Human Services in Child Protection with a Conc. in Emergency Prep. Vulnerable Populations

Nova Southeastern University's Fischler College of Education and School of Criminal Justice offers an online Master of Human Services in Child Protection program with a concentration in Emergency Preparedness for Vulnerable Populations. The Emergency Preparedness for Vulnerable Populations concentration provides competency-based child protective services instruction aimed at closing the gap between ground level on-the-job training and scientifically grounded best-practices. It will develop the critical knowledge, values, and skills necessary for child protection professionals to respond effectively to complex problems confronting children and families in the child protective services system. Students will complete the thirty-three credit hour program that includes six core courses and three concentration courses.

The Master of Human Services in Child Protection is a 33-credit hour program which includes six core courses at four credits each (24 core credits total) and to earn a concentration in Emergency Preparedness for Vulnerable Populations requires three courses at three credits each (9 credit hours total) within the Emergency Preparedness for Vulnerable Populations concentration.
