St. Petersburg College offers an Associate Degree in Emergency Administration and Management. The EAM degree integrates the broad focus of policy, planning and administration with the practical, technical and communication aspects of emergency response. Students learn to write emergency plans to meet state and federal guidelines and communicate knowledgeably with expert advisors in a crisis, as well as gain an understanding of problems facing response teams. Students can also take courses in the Homeland Security track for this degree.
