Thomas Edison State University offers an online Graduate Certificate in Homeland Security. The program provides students with a broad view of homeland security issues by going beyond a single discipline to consider policy, preparation, management and continuity throughout a crisis. The 12-credit graduate program is offered completely online and may be transferred into the Master of Arts in Liberal Studies or Master of Science in Management programs.
