The University of Findlay, Center for Terrorism Preparedness is offering Terrorism Preparedness Training Courses. The purpose is to develop integrated training programs that will assist communities in the prevention of, preparation for, response to, and recovery from possible terrorist incidents and comparable natural disasters. The training is designed for emergency preparedness needs of corporate safety and security personnel, firefighters, emergency medical and law enforcement personnel, the medical community, school personnel, and the maritime and transportation industry. Training is provided by experts recognized for their expertise in emergency preparedness and is held at the University of Findlay and at client locations around the country.

### **Courses include but are not limited to:**

First Responder I (WMD)  
Community Vulnerability Assessment Methodology  
Threat Assessment Management (TAM)  
Writing an Anti-Terrorism/Asset Protection Plan  
Workplace Violence/Critical Incident /The Aftermath  
TAM for Prevention of Targeted Violence in Schools

Training courses grant academic credits or CEUs. CEUs are granted for continuing education requirements for credentials such as the CHMM, CET or REHS. Students are provided academic credits towards their Bachelor of Science Degree or their Master of Science degree if the course has been approved internally for academic credits and if the student is enrolled in the University.
