

## **University of Massachusetts Lowell – Graduate Certificate in Security Studies**

The University of Massachusetts Lowell offers an online Graduate Certificate in Security Studies. The program is offered through the Criminal Justice Department in conjunction with the Division of Online and Continuing Education. The certificate program is designed for professionals working in the areas of public safety, security management, and law enforcement; managers in corporations responsible for overseeing in-house security programs; and information technology professionals. Criminal justice students can broaden their career options in security within private industry by electing to earn the certificate in security management and homeland security.

All courses can be applied toward the University of Massachusetts Lowell's Online Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice. You can earn the Certificate in Security Studies entirely online.
