

**University of Wisconsin-Green Bay - Bachelors degree in Public Administration with an emphasis in Emergency Management**

The University of Wisconsin Green Bay offers a Bachelors degree in Public Administration with an emphasis in Emergency Management. This program focuses on the life cycle of an emergency. Coursework in budgeting, mitigation, planning, response, and recovery from natural and man-made disasters are studied. Students will come away with good critical thinking skills and an in-depth, big picture understanding of the complexity of disasters, whether caused by nature or is man-made. This program is designed to prepare students for management positions in agencies that provide varied emergency management related services.

All public administration majors must complete the major requirements plus the following in order to earn an emphasis in Emergency Management.
