Waldorf University offers a Bachelor of Arts in Emergency Management with Optional Concentrations in Fire Science or Homeland Security. The Bachelor of Arts degree in Emergency Management is designed to prepare the students with a broad base of knowledge in the field of emergency management. The foundation for this degree program includes the Waldorf general education curriculum, numerous courses in the emergency management arena, as well as electives in the fields of Homeland Security, Fire Science Administration, and Business, among others. The program provides students with the general education, discipline-specific, and technical knowledge required to succeed in the diverse field of emergency management.

Estimated time to complete the bachelor's degree program is four years with full-time enrollment.

- A grade of C or higher in all coursework in the major and, if applicable, in the concentration(s)
- 2.00 cumulative grade point average for work completed at Waldorf
