The Emergency Management curriculum is designed to provide students with a foundation of technical and professional knowledge needed for individuals seeking careers in the emergency management field to work in governmental agencies and private industry. Study involves both management and technical aspects of emergency management.

Course work includes classroom and laboratory exercises to introduce the student to various aspects of emergency management. Students will learn technical and administrative skills such as hazard analysis and risk assessment, emergency planning, business continuity, emergency operations, finance, incident management, public relations, and management.
