Qualifications:

Candidates must have a Master's degree in emergency management or a related discipline and be a certified emergency manager (CEM) or Doctorate preferred (ABDs with confirmed completion date may be considered).

- Experience designing and teaching college level courses
- Demonstrates expertise in clinical practice
- Experience in developing community partnerships
- On-line teaching experience
- Strong administrative and communication skills are required
- The successful candidate will have experience and/or interest in curriculum development and assessment of student learning, a commitment to student success, and the ability to successfully interact harmoniously with colleagues, staff, and students within a multicultural environment.

The Emergency Services and Emergency Management Programs: The Emergency Services and Emergency Management programs are offered through University College. Both programs are designed primarily for working students, use an asynchronous distance learning approach, and are directed by a full-time program faculty member.

1. A cover letter explaining your interest in this position and a summary of your experience in emergency management.
2. A curriculum vitae, including a statement about your experience with emergency management curriculum development, experiences of establishing new agreements with institutions for practicum placement, and online course development.
