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## EM/DP PROGRAM CERTIFICATE

The Emergency Management and Disaster Planning (EM/DP) Program offers a certificate as well as an associate degree option to the student interested in EM/DP as a career or as a strong addition to any professional pursuit. The courses for the certificate, upon completion with a grade of "C" or above, may be applied towards the EM/DP General Studies Associate Degree.

### GENERAL PROGRAM CERTIFICATE
