

Research Proposal Submission Template

The NTED HiEd Program will fund competitive multidisciplinary applied research proposals that examine real world complex problems and provide actionable recommendations to advance the discipline of emergency management. For a proposal to be considered it must; (1) come from individuals/teams currently associated with an institute of higher education, (2) align with the 2022-2026 FEMA Strategic Plan and Next Generation Core Competencies, and (3) follow the template format for submission.

All proposals will be evaluated by a committee and relevant subject matter experts for technical quality of research design, alignment to FEMA priorities, contribution to the practice of emergency management, and editorial quality of the proposal. Proposals should be scoped for a 3-9 month period of performance.

If funded, researchers will be expected to participate in monthly status meetings with a member of the HiEd Team and provide a detailed workplan. All projects will need to be reviewed and approved by the HiEd Program Manager before acceptance and final payment.
