Lecturer Position

Position:

The Department of Public Administration in the College of Public Affairs and Community Service invites applications for a lecturer position starting August 15, 2011. This is a three-year appointment renewable annually.

Responsibilities:

Primary teaching responsibilities are in the department's undergraduate emergency administration and planning program (EADP). The successful candidate must be capable of teaching core courses including the introductory course as well as hazard mitigation and preparedness and disaster response and recovery.

Qualifications:

Candidates must be at least ABD with evidence of progress toward completing a doctorate in emergency administration or related field at the time the appointment begins.

Setting:

The University of North Texas, the largest and most comprehensive university in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, has more than 36,000 students, one-fourth of whom are graduate students. The EADP program is the first of its kind in the nation and is internationally recognized as one of the leaders in the field. The department offers a Master of Public Administration degree that is nationally ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* in the area of city management and urban policy, and a selective Ph.D. in public administration and management. Proximity to the D-FW metropolitan area, which includes hundreds of local governments, many non-profit organizations and foundations, and federal regional headquarters, affords numerous opportunities for research and student experiential learning.

Application Procedures:

Applicants must submit a letter of interest, current vita, unofficial transcripts, and contact information for three references. Candidates must be eligible to work in the U.S. prior to the appointment start date.
