Tenure Track Position

Position:

The Department of Public Administration in the College of Public Affairs and Community Service invites applications for an assistant professor position starting August 15, 2011. This is a tenure-track appointment.

Responsibilities:

Teaching responsibilities are primarily in emergency management in the department's three degree programs – the PhD program, Master of Public Administration program, and undergraduate program in emergency administration and planning.

Qualifications:

Candidates must hold an earned doctorate in disaster studies, emergency or public administration or related field and teaching experience appropriate to rank. Candidates with research and teaching interests in emergency management and at least one other area of public administration are desired.

Setting:

The University of North Texas, the largest and most comprehensive university in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, has more than 36,000 students and one-fourth of whom are graduate students. The M.P.A. program is nationally ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* in the area of city management and urban policy. The department offers a B.S. in Emergency Administration and Planning, the first of its kind in the nation, and a Ph.D. in public administration and management. Proximity to the D-FW metropolitan area, which includes hundreds of local governments, many non-profit organizations and foundations, and federal regional headquarters, affords numerous opportunities for research and student experiential learning.

Application Procedures:

Candidates must be eligible to work in the U.S. prior to the appointment start date.
