This webinar series provides an overview of the use of cases in teaching emergency management higher education programs.

The second webinar in the Emergency Management Teaching with Cases series will explore the ways cases can be used to develop professional practice competencies, which is one type of learning outcome associated with the use of cases. With this approach, students engage in a realistic activity that calls on them to apply knowledge developed through their course and program of study. The common elements of the structure of this type of case activity will be discussed, and examples of variations to the approach will be offered. You will come away from this session with information on how to use existing case libraries, case journals, as well as other resources to support the integration of this particular case method into your teaching. The session will conclude by discussing resources available to support you in developing and publishing case studies so that they can be used by others in the emergency management field.
