Course Description:

The course is an online, self-guided training. The goal is to provide an overview of the requirements for state hazard mitigation plans that are found in the State Mitigation Planning Policy Guide (2022). The State Mitigation Planning Policy Guide is FEMA's official policy on, and interpretation of, state hazard mitigation planning requirements set in 44 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 201.

Course Goal:

Upon successfully completing the course, the participants will be able to:

- Explain the purpose and intent of state hazard mitigation planning.
- Present three guiding principles that are used in plan reviews.
- Describe the requirements for standard state hazard mitigation plans.
- Describe the requirements for enhanced state hazard mitigation plans.
- Describe the submission and review procedures for both standard and enhanced state hazard mitigation plans.
- Locate additional hazard mitigation resources.
